Vinyl Wrap Installation Process



Step 1: Position



- When the artists create their designs, they include an extra few inches of design, or bleed, around their image. The installers use this extra material to correctly position the vinyl on the side of the box. They then tape it into place before getting to work.

Step 2: Peel & Stick



- Starting at the top of the box, the installers peel away the backing from the vinyl in small sections and stick it to the surface of the box.

Step 3: Cut



- To accommodate protrusions, handles, and openings, the installers stretch the vinyl and cut along the edges of each protrusion.

Step 4: Scrape



- The installers pull the vinyl taut and use scrapers to help eliminate air bubbles.

Step 5: Line It Up

- The installers look at how the design wraps around the box to determine where to position the next panel. Once they have the vinyl positioned, they begin the process again.
